As reported in the September 2013 edition of Council's Newsletter, Council continues to build on its strengths where the Shire of Goomalling was ranked No. 1 Local Government Authority in Australia in the categories of economic fundamentals and Value of Building approvals per capita, it is therefore very pleasing to report that Council has now received approval of its successful grant application of \$900,000 approximately to construct four (4) aged care independent living units in the Goomalling Townsite. Goomalling's submission was part of the AROC regional submission to construct ILU's in the Shires of Goomalling, Toodyay and Victoria Plains. It is anticipated that the units will be completed in early 2015.

Council reiterated its unanimous stance to strongly oppose any decision by the State Government to force local government amalgamations in rural WA, as Council continues to build its strength in sound financial performances, strong asset base and solid standing as a leading local government in Australia as stated by the report prepared by Regional Australia Institute in July 2013.

Fire Brigade/Fire Fighting Membership Forms

Are you an active Fire Fighter attending bush fires on your own property or a neighbours etc.? We need you to register your details with the Department Fire and Emergency Services so that you are fully covered by insurance in the case of attending a fire.

It is extremely important that you are registered correctly. Please contact Jess or Tahnee at the Shire Office to find out if you are already correctly registered or to obtain the correct form to be added to the membership list.

Reporting Fires to '000'

This is an important reminder to the residents of the Shire that if you see smoke or fire that it's very critical that you first ring "000" and not the local captain or fire control officer.

By ringing "000" first this will alert all of the required agencies and personnel that a fire may be in the area, this process may be hindered if the appropriate action of dialling "000" first is not followed.

So please ring "000" for any emergency and provide as much precise detail as you can and stay safe this fire season!

Slater Homestead Closure over Christmas/New Year

It is advised that the Slater Homestead will be closed from December through to the end of February.

New Cat Laws

From the 1st November 2013, a new Law was passed that by the time a cat reaches six months of age, it is a requirement that the cat is registered with the local government where the cat ordinarily lives. They are also now required to be micro-chipped and sterilised and are to be registered at the same cost as registering a dog.

New Microchipping Laws for Dogs

From the 1st November 2013 new Laws were passed that now require all dogs are to be micro-chipped before registration, from 3 months of age.

All dogs that are currently already licenced have to be, if not already, micro-chipped by October 2015. If your dog is already micro-chipped, you need to advise the Shire of the number and provide a copy of the documentation if possible, otherwise a declaration needs to be made for recording on your dogs registration details.

Knick Knacks is Moving!

Recent Parvo Disease Outbreak in Dogs

Dog owners are asked to be diligent with their dogs as there have been recent cases of Parvo disease spreading around Goomalling and taking the lives of puppies.

The disease is called canine Parvovirus or more commonly known as Parvo, within our shire we have had 6 cases of Parvo and the result has been death.

There are two forms of Parvo, cardiac and intestinal, cardiac form is less common and affects puppies infected in the uterus shortly after birth until about 8 weeks of age. The virus attacks the heart muscle and the puppy often dies suddenly or after a brief period of breathing difficulty. Intestinal form is where the pup is infected through oral contact with feces or infected soil. Following the ingestion the virus replicates the tissue in the throat and then spreads to the bloodstream. From there, the virus attacks rapidly dividing the cells. The virus is usually more deadly if the host is incorrectly infested with worms and other intestinal parasites.

Survival rate depends on how quickly the virus is diagnosed, the age of the dog and how aggressive the treatment is.

Treatment usually involves extensive hospitalisation, due to the severe dehydration and damage to the intestines and bone marrow. A test should be given as early as possible if CPV is suspected in order to begin early treatment and increase survival rate.

Contact your Vet if you notice any symptoms with your dog.



- Broadcast over ABC Geraldton & Perth, Radiowest & Hot FM

Saturday & Sundays AFTER Christmas

It is advised that Harvest Bans will be imposed when the Bureau of Meteorology has issued the Fire Weather Forecasts as follows:

Very High, Extreme, Severe & Catastrophic Fire Danger

Automatic Harvest/Movement of Vehicle Ban Ban will remain in place for the respective day to 6.00pm

Weather forecasts can be obtained from the Bureau of Meteorology on 9263 2260 between 6.00am and 4.15pm 7 days a week. Outside hours contact 9263 2258 (24 hours) or visit the website www.bom.gov.au.

Public Holidays - HARVESTING NOT PERMITTED

It is advised that Harvesting is <u>NOT PERMITTED</u> on the following days:

Christmas Day – Wednesday 25 December 2013 Boxing Day - Thursday 26 December 2013 New Years Day – Wednesday 1 January 2014

Should there be any changes to the above dates, they will be published in Councils December Newsletter as well as the Goomalling Endeavour Newspaper in early December.

Normal procedures will resume for Friday 27 December, Monday 30th and Tuesday 31st December with notifications being sent out by the Chief Bush Fire Control Officer should a harvest ban be imposed.

Harvesting is permitted on Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th December 2013 subject to the fire weather forecast being HIGH or lower. A Harvest Ban will be imposed automatically when the Bureau of Meteorology has issued the Fire Weather Forecasts as follows for the Avon Region (Shire of Goomalling):

Very High, Extreme, Severe & Catastrophic Fire Danger

Automatic Harvest/Movement of Vehicle Ban Ban will remain in place for the day to 7.00pm

Notification will not be provided on these 2 days, therefore farmers need to be aware of up-to-date weather conditions throughout these days. It is also reminded that as this is the holiday period, our emergency service volunteer numbers will be limited.

Burning Permits

Burning is prohibited from the 1st November 2013 to 14th February 2014 and once again Bush Fire Permits will be issued for restricted burning from the 15th February until the 29th March 2014, subject to further extensions if required. In the past, Council has extended the restricted burning season by 2 lots of 2 weeks which will take the season end from the 29th March to the 26th April.

Everyone should have received a Fire Prevention Checklist with their rates this year. This checklist includes a lot of very valuable information regarding firebreak requirements and information on burning of garden refuse and rubbish.
