EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - OIL RECYCLING

Background

The Oil Recycling Station was a Commonwealth environmental initiative. The Shire of Goomalling acknowledged the environmental benefit and was grateful of this opportunity to assist farmers and businesses to dispose of this waste product appropriately.

Part of the Commonwealth initiative was a partnership with Wren Oil who were contracted to collect the oil at no charge for use in their recycling program. This partnership was finite and has been discontinued.

The oil recycling station is currently housed at the DrumMuster Depot and Council is unable to provide the labour to facilitate this recycling initiative but still recognise the value of recycling this waste product so is seeking expressions of interest from persons able and willing to house the Oil Station.



- The successful applicant will be responsible for the removal and relocation of the Oil Station.
- The Oil Station would need to be accessible to receive oil during business hours.
- Wren Oil continues to be in the market but now charge a fee of 25 cents per litre; all management of the oil recycling would need to be undertaken by the successful applicant.
