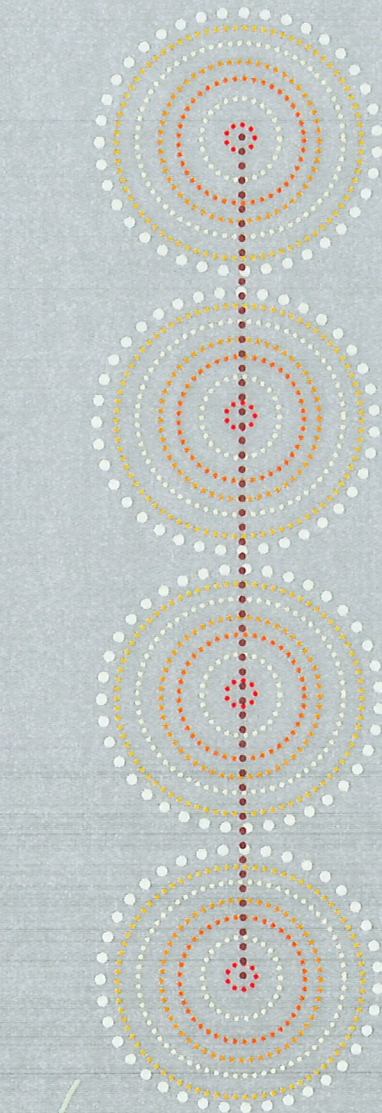

Summary

To consider the partial closure of 053 Quinlan Street.

Background

In 2018 Council adopted the Goomalling Recreation Masterplan which was a document developed by the community about the future development of the recreation precinct and with plans to redevelop the Town hall and surrounding areas. The Masterplan was a method of community input into the future development of these facilities and was facilitated by AECOM independently of the Council with the community.

As part of the wider process, the CEO sought further public comment during May and June 2023 about the closure of the road and there were several submissions. A petition was circulated for many weeks by a member of the community seeking support for an objection "to the closure of Quinlan Street and the development of an Intergenerational Community Hub".

As a wider process, the CEO sought further public comment during May and June 2023 about the closure of 053 Quinlan Street and there were several submissions. The petitioners did not have significant issues with the various elements of the plan but seemed to be objecting primarily to Quinlan Street being closed. The consultation undertaken was about the closure of Quinlan Street and nothing more.

At the Ordinary Council Meeting held in July 2023 Council reviewed the submissions provided through consultation period for the closure of a portion of Quinlan Street and committed to having further consultation and directed the CEO to engage with stakeholders, including but not limited to, Minister for Planning, Lands, Housing, to request the Minister consider the proposal to close Quinlan Street as a thoroughfare between Lockyer Street and Hoddy Street.

Consultation

It was noted during consultation that an Intergenerational Activity Concept was to create a space where differing demographics of the community could share broader spaces while still maintaining their individual spaces. The Town Hall was to be redeveloped into areas such as a youth learning area, shared spaces for seniors and sporting groups such as Karate, covered outdoor play space for early childhood learning and a redevelopment of Gumnuts. This demonstrates a colocation of facilities which makes it easier to source grant funding for the development of facilities.

Additionally, construction around the area to create more individualised spaces and to create an integrated community centre styled facility. This represents the modern-day approach to defining an agile activity space. An intergenerational activity centre is about the whole community and not just youth or senior utilisation.

The proposed closure of Quinlan Street would see additional safety at the road intersection and see reduced incidents of near collision. It shall also provide additional circulation space that would see a connective approach to a community space incorporating the Goomalling oval, sports club and gym area.

The partial closure of 053 Quinlan Street will improve road safety, especially around school areas and aid in progression of site development in accordance with the Recreation Master Plan. The recreational Master Plan is approaching ten years old and will be reviewed in the financial year 2026/27 for potential improvements and financial value management.

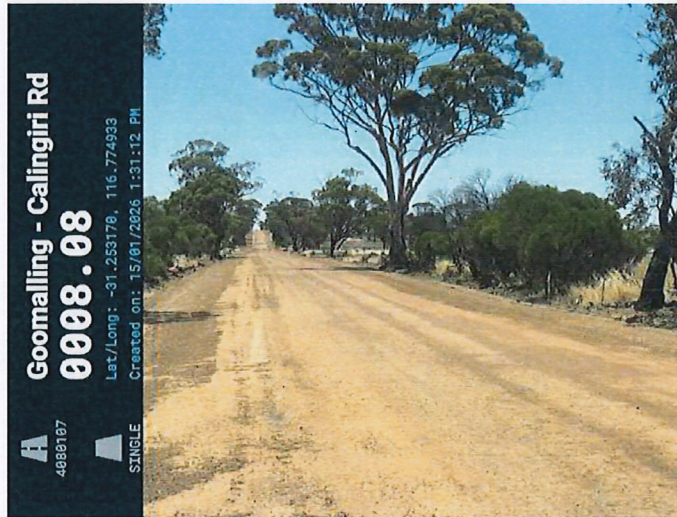
11.1 Works Manager Report

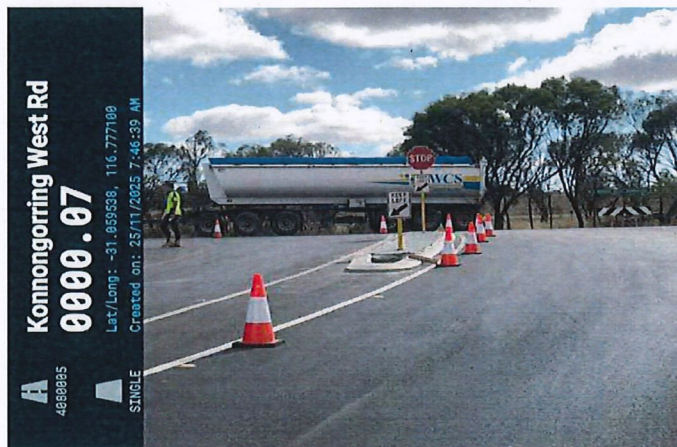
Current work is being conducted with a combination of shire staff and contractors.

Konnongorring West Road RTR – T junction works. – SLK 0.00 to 0.16

Road construction works have been completed. Rock pitching is anticipated to be in February which will complete all upgrade works. Final recoup and Certificates of Completion will be submitted to MRWA also in February/March to close out the project.

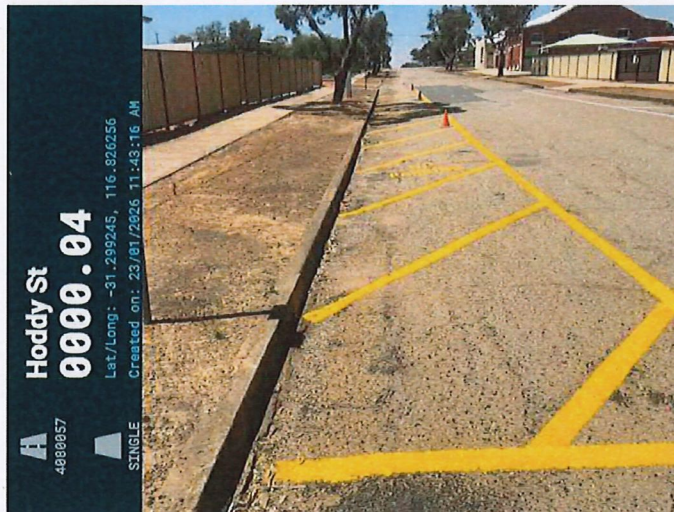


ROAD MAINTENANCE –




