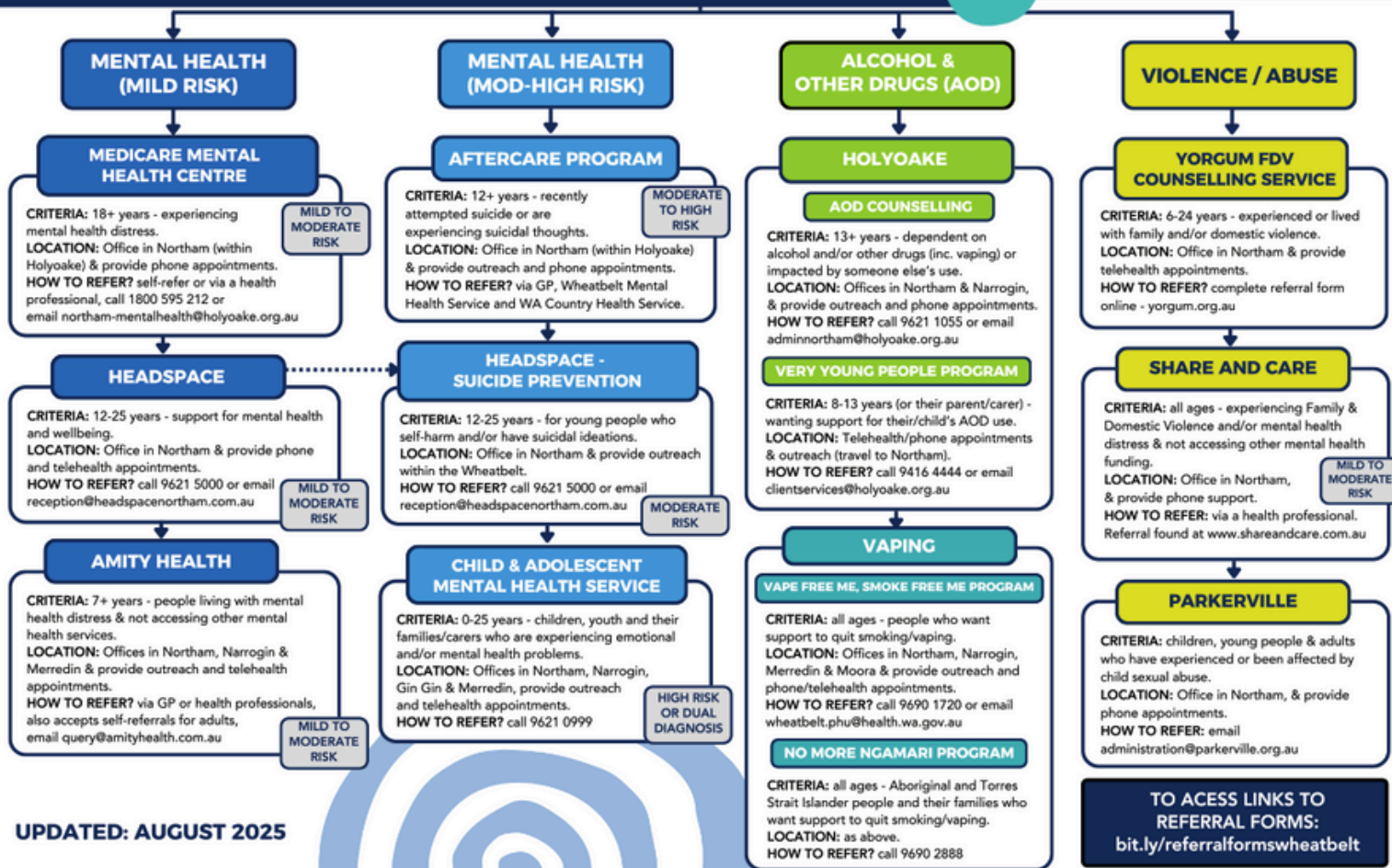

2025 Local Government Elections



Local government is a vital level of democracy and councils provide important services that community members and businesses rely on every day.

Elected members have a range of responsibilities and are able to make positive changes for their community and residents in their local area.

To nominate in a local government election, the candidate must be an Australian citizen over 18-years-of-age, be a resident, property owner or occupier in their district, and have completed the mandatory local government candidate induction.

Nominations for candidates open on 28 August and close at 4pm on 4 September 2025.

2025 Local Government Elections

Local government elections in Western Australia will take place on Saturday 18 October 2025.

Local government elections are usually conducted by post, however a small number of local councils request to hold an in-person election. Local councils who will be holding an in-person election will be available here soon.

Key dates

Enrolment – Check, update or enrol to vote by 5pm 22 August 2025

Nominations Open – 28 August 2025

Close of nominations - 4pm 4 September 2025

Postal elections – Elections packages (including ballot papers, candidate information and how-to-vote information) will be sent out in September 2025

In person elections - Vote in person on election day, vote early or apply for a postal vote from your local government (councils holding an in-person election will be available here at the end of July)

Enrol to vote

All eligible electors must enrol to vote. When you enrol to vote, you are enrolled for Commonwealth, State and local government elections. You can check your enrolment, check your details or update your enrolment online. at <https://www.elections.wa.gov.au>.

This is important if you have:

- moved house
- changed your name
- turned 18 recently
- become an Australian citizen
- not yet joined the electoral roll or
- want to check or update your enrolment details

How to vote

Optional preferential voting is the voting system used in Local government elections. This means you have the choice to number the candidates in the order of your preference. You do not have to number all the boxes if you don't want to.

You have the choice to:

vote for one candidate - by putting a 1 next to their name

vote for some candidates - by numbering several candidates in the order of your preference

vote for all candidates - in the order of your preference

Who can vote

Residents

All residents in a local government district who are enrolled on the State electoral roll are automatically enrolled on the corresponding local government roll. You must make sure you are correctly enrolled, and your details are up to date by 5pm 22 August to vote in the Local government elections.

Owners and Occupiers

People who own or occupy rateable property within a local government district, can apply to their local government to be included on the roll as an owner/occupier, as long as they are eligible electors.

Supply Chain Capacity Program

The Supply Chain Capacity Program will assist Western Australian sheep producers and supply chain businesses to adjust to the removal of live sheep exports by sea and moderate the impact of the change.



As part of the Australian Government's \$139.7 million transition assistance package, the Supply Chain Capacity Program will assist WA sheep producers and supply chain businesses to adjust to the cessation of live sheep exports by sea and moderate the impact of the change.

The program, administered by Regional Business Development Corporation, aims to ensure the onshore processing supply chain in WA is better positioned to meet the demands of processing sheep following the phase out of live exports by sea.

It will incentivise investment in on-farm and processing infrastructure before the end of the trade to build confidence in the sheep industry and capture future opportunities.

WA STOLEN GENERATIONS REDRESS SCHEME

Information for community members before the Scheme opens

On 27 May 2025 the WA Government announced a redress scheme for Stolen Generations survivors in WA (the WA Stolen Generations Redress Scheme).

The Department of Premier and Cabinet (the Department) is the lead Government agency coordinating the implementation of the Scheme. The Department is working with WA's two peak Stolen Generations organisations, **Yokai - Healing Our Spirit** and **Kimberley Stolen Generations Aboriginal Corporation**, to ensure the Scheme is informed by strong Aboriginal voices with lived experience of the Stolen Generations.

The Department has prepared this information pack to help community organisations and government agencies respond to queries from members of the public, and direct people to the Department when needed.

More detailed information will be distributed when the Scheme opens later in 2025.

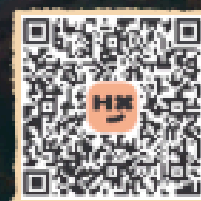

What is BioSPHERE Boodja?

BioSPHERE Boodja is a free-entry arts and culture festival that celebrates art, Country, and community, held right here in Goomalling. Over two days, the town transforms into a living canvas — with live music, immersive installations, storytelling, workshops, and a spectacular evening puppet procession with projections onto the CBH grain domes.

This event was created to:

- Celebrate art as a pathway for young people.
- Showcase Goomalling and increase tourism to the region.
- Bring people together for a shared, memorable experience.
- Provide a fundraising opportunity for Goomalling clubs and community groups.

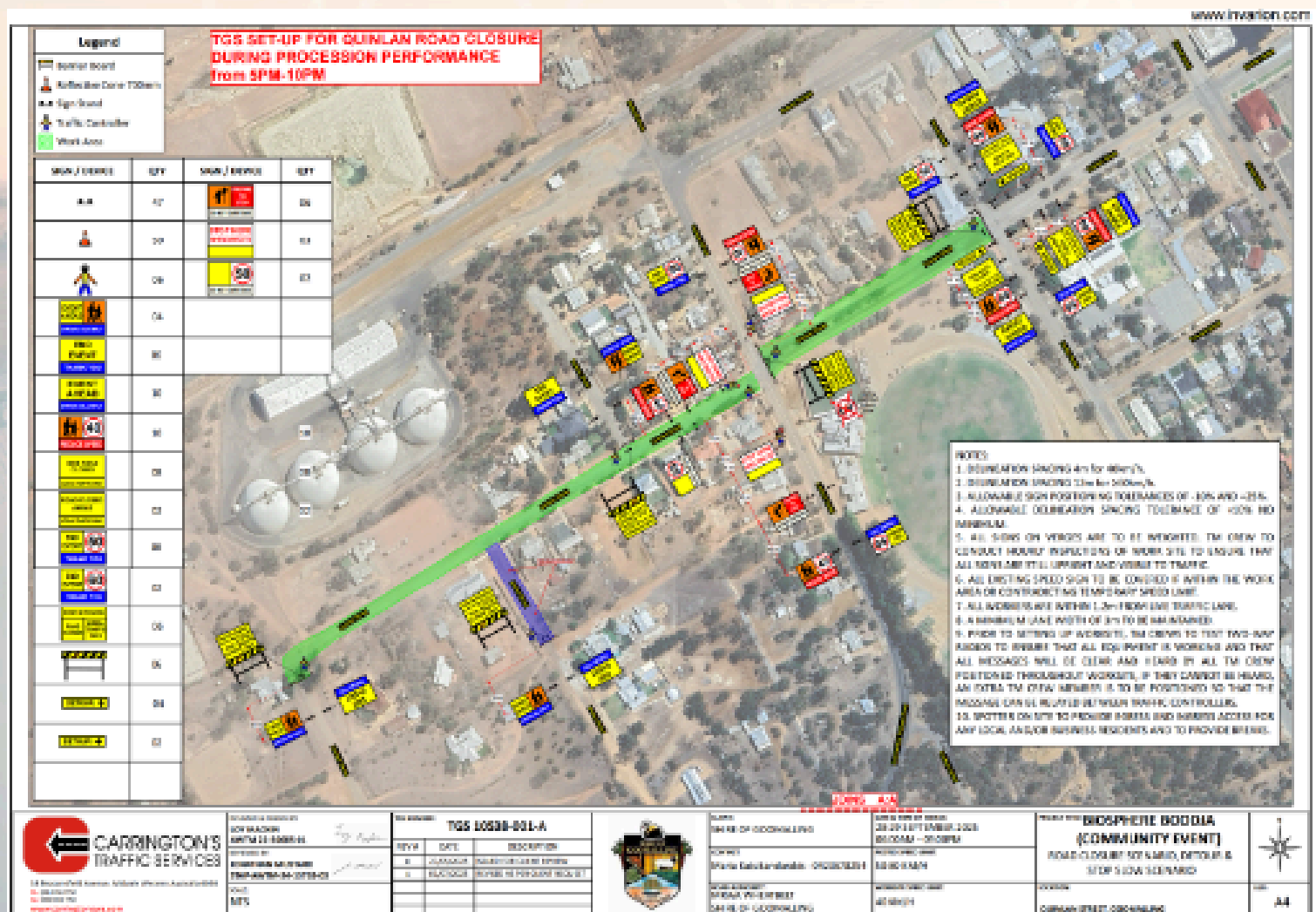
Traffic and Road Closures - Quinlan Street

To keep everyone safe during the festival:

- From 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM, half of Quinlan Street (from Hoddy Street to Lockyer Street) will be closed.
- From 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM, the entire road will be closed for the evening puppet processions and for large crowds moving between the Recreation Centre and the CBH Domes. (note: road closure between Lockyer and Grange St doesn't start until 5pm)
- Alternate routes will be signposted.

Residents of Quinlan Street have been notified of this closure in advance. Please plan ahead if you need to travel during these times, and follow directions from traffic management staff. Thank you for your patience and support in keeping the event safe for everyone.
