



LONG-AWAITED BOWLING GREEN PROJECT COMPLETE

The Shire is delighted to announce that the long-awaited Bowling Green replacement project has now been completed.

While the project experienced a slight delay, the end result has been well worth the wait. Once the existing turf was removed, unexpected issues with the underlying subgrade were uncovered, requiring additional remediation works to ensure a high-quality and long-lasting playing surface. These essential works extended the project by several weeks.

Fortunately, the weather played in our favour during the final stages of construction, allowing the project to progress smoothly to completion.

A special thank you goes to the dedicated members of the Goomalling Bowling Club, who generously volunteered their time to complete the final stage of the project. Club members contributed more than 40 hours of green rolling, an important process that ensures the surface is properly consolidated and ready for competition.

This project is a significant investment in the future of lawn bowls in Goomalling and provides a first-class facility for current members, visiting teams and future generations of bowlers.

The Shire extends its sincere appreciation to the Bowling Club volunteers for their commitment and hard work, and thanks the community for its patience throughout the project. We look forward to seeing the new green enjoyed for many years to come.

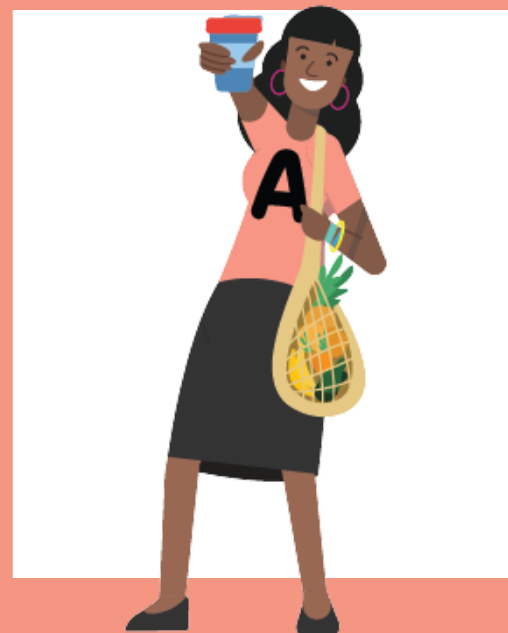

Koomalin Clay Artist-in-Residence Program 2026

Gaia Leonardi

We're excited to welcome Gaia Leonardi to our community in Term 3. Gaia is an Italian ceramic artist and educator from Bottega Mirta Morigi in Faenza, bringing her unique blend of contemporary ceramics, creativity, and embodied learning.

She will be offering workshops in our schools as well as community workshops, inviting participants of all ages to explore clay through touch, play, and imagination. We're thrilled to have her join us and look forward to the inspiration she'll bring.

Gaia Leonardi moves through the world the way clay moves through her hands— with patience, intuition, and a quiet devotion to transformation.

Rooted in Faenza, the cradle of Italian ceramics, she shapes earth, breath, and gesture into a single language. Her work carries the softness of touch, the rhythm of the body, and the stories that emerge when hands meet material. In the studio of Bottega Mirta Morigi, she learned to listen to clay: its weight, its memory, its willingness to become.

Her practice is not confined to objects. It is a living dialogue— between movement and stillness, between children discovering their first coil of clay, between communities learning to feel at home in their bodies again.

As a psychomotor therapist, yoga teacher, and ceramic artist, Gaia weaves together the tactile and the emotional, the sculptural and the somatic. Her workshops are spaces where people breathe, play, ground, and create—where clay becomes a companion for self-expression and connection.

Her art is an invitation: to touch the world more gently, to shape it with intention, to remember that creation begins in the body long before it reaches the hands.

Waste Sorted Kids



Children explore sustainability through **three hands-on Waste Sorted Kids workshops**. **Making Compost in a Bottle**, they learn how composting works and create their own bottle compost to watch the process develop over time.

Exploring Compost Creatures invites children to investigate real compost samples, observe tiny invertebrates with magnifiers, and record their discoveries in a mini booklet.

Waste Incursion helps children understand local bin systems and practice sorting waste correctly, finishing with a creative reuse craft to reinforce the importance of reducing and reusing materials.

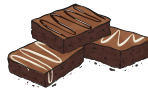


RECOGNITION AND APPRECIATION

The headmasters' house was built in 1906 as a teacher's residence for the Goomalling townsite school. A single classroom school was built at the same time on Throssell Street, south-east of the house, and classes began in July 1906. Eleven students were enrolled in December 1907, thirty three in 1909, forty in 1913 and, in 1919, three teachers were required for the sixty seven pupils.

The school had various additions as student numbers grew, and classes were held in various buildings around the townsite, including the CWA on Forward Street.

The house, which originally consisted of a kitchen, single bedroom, living room and bathroom, was extended in 1927 to accommodate the teaching staff.

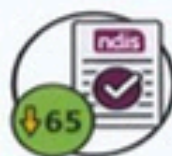

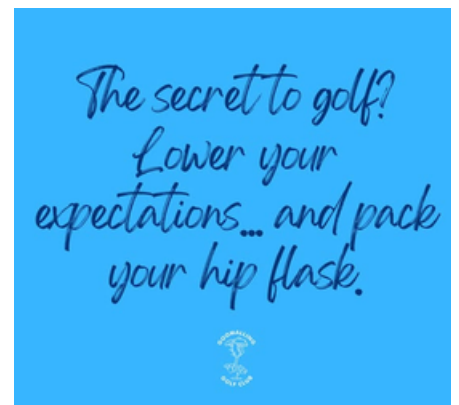

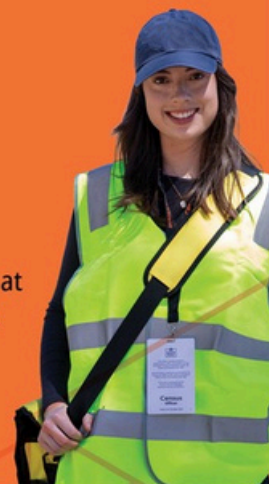
