


Summary

The purpose of this report is to present sufficient information to Council to enable adoption of a Waste Management Policy.

Background

The objective of this Waste Management Policy is to provide direction to ensure an economical and efficient waste collection service for the Goomalling community, that also identifies procedures and directions for the ongoing development and maintenance of a sustainable system that includes the collection, disposal, recycling and minimisation of material from the Shire of Goomalling.

Consultation

Shire of Goomalling will work with the current waste collection contractor Avon Waste to ensure: -

- Council provides a weekly collection of domestic type waste for all occupied premises including dwellings, premises and other rateable properties also,
- Council provides a fortnightly collection of domestic type recyclable materials for all occupied premises including occupied dwellings, premises and other rateable properties.

Council will continue to strive for achieving waste reduction goals and targets areas of maximum demand to ensure that waste minimisation is achievable. This will be done through effective programmes that encourage waste avoidance, reduction, reuse and recycling of waste.

Statutory Environment

The Local Government Act 1995 outlines the roles of Council and the Chief Executive Officer.

Policy Implications

This is a new policy that will be subject to review every five (5) years or sooner at the discretion of the Chief Executive Officer.
