The WA Government has launched the \$25 million Regional Housing Support Fund to boost housing and land development across regional Western Australia.

Administered by the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage, grants of up to \$5 million are available to support the development of key worker housing, community housing and Residential subdivisions.


Eligible applicants include local governments, community housing providers, developers and landowners.

Do you have a "Go Bag" ready incase you need to evacuate?

Preparing a "Go Bag" for bushfire evacuation is essential for ensuring your safety and readiness in case of an emergency. Your Go Bag should include things such as:

- Emergency contact numbers (make a list to keep in your "Go Bag".
- Mobile phone.
- Change of clothing, nightie, underwear, etc.
- Continence aids, if applicable (pads, IDC bag, etc.)
- Medication and medication list.
- · Glasses, hearing aids, walking aids.
- Copy of recent care plan from your GP.
- Special items (photo albums, etc.)
- Bottle of water.

Preparing yourself and your property for bushfires is crucial to ensure safety and minimize damage. Start by creating a defensible space around your home: clear away dry leaves, branches, and other flammable materials, and trim trees and shrubs to reduce fuel for

fires. Ensure your gutters are clean and free of debris. Have a bushfire survival plan in place, and make sure all family members know what to do in case of an emergency.

Stay informed about fire conditions through local news and alerts. By taking these proactive steps, you can better protect yourself, your loved ones, and your property from the threat of bushfires. Stay safe and prepared!
