WHATS HAPPENING IN WORKS



Meckering Road Prime Sealing

Prime sealing of the Meckering Road in May 2026 resulted in the completion of this section of works as part of Regional Road Group (RRG) funding.

The RRGs are comprised of elected representatives from each Local Government within the road group. Most groups are supported by a sub-group or technical committee comprised of Local Government staff. Administrative support is provided by Main Roads WA. RRGs importantly provide Local Government with a voice in how the State Government's contribution to local roads is spent. RRG members serve a vital and valuable role in ensuring road funding decisions maximise community benefits and preserve and improve the public road network across Western Australia.

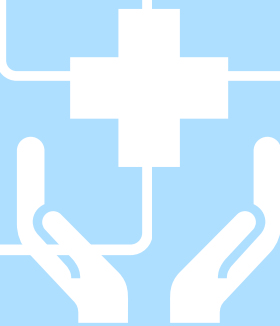

Introducing AusAlert™

In October 2026, the Australian Government is launching AusAlert – a new national warning system that uses the latest technology to send emergency messages to compatible mobile devices.

What is AusAlert?

AusAlert is a fast and reliable way to help communities be informed and better prepared during local and national emergencies.

What is AusAlert for?

AusAlert gives the Australian Government and state and territory emergency services organisations the ability to send national or local alerts about disasters. These could be natural hazards such as bushfires, floods, cyclones and tsunamis, or events like public health emergencies, security threats or biosecurity incidents. It's just one of the many ways we're helping to keep Australians safer in times of disaster.

How does AusAlert work?

AusAlert uses the latest technology to send near-instant emergency messages to compatible mobile devices during disasters.

What are the different types of AusAlert?

There are 2 main types of AusAlert:

- **Critical Alerts** are used for the most serious emergencies. They can't be opted out of.
- **Priority Alerts** are used for emergencies where there is a heightened level of threat because conditions are changing. They can be opted out of.

What will be included in an AusAlert?

An AusAlert will be written in English and will let you know the type of emergency, where it's located, how serious it is and how to respond. It will also tell you the name of the emergency organisation that has sent the AusAlert and where to find more information about the emergency.

Fuel Support Payment available for valid driver licence holders from 1 July

From 1 July 2026, all eligible Western Australian driver's licence holders can apply for the Fuel Support Payment.

The State Government has announced the one-off \$100 payment as a cost-of-living measure in the 2026-27 State Budget to assist Western Australian drivers with fuel costs and other financial pressures.

All WA driver's licence, learner's permit, provisional and extraordinary licence holders can apply. People with a cancelled, suspended or expired WA driver's licence are not eligible to apply.

You can claim the Fuel Support Payment on the ServiceWA app from 1 July 2026. Visit the [ServiceWA app: Support hub](#) for help to set up your ServiceWA app ahead of time.

Alternative claim options will also be available for people who are unable or do not wish to use the app with information provided soon.

More information about the Fuel Support Payment will be provided closer to the 1 July 2026 launch date.
