# GO CIRCULAR: BE A GREAT SORT PROGRAM URBAN REVOLUTION WORKSHOP: GROWING YOUR OWN FOOD

Our community gathered on 20 June for a dynamic GO Circular – Be a Great Sort Program workshop delivered in partnership with Urban Revolution, welcoming an engaged group of 15 participants. This session built on the first two foundational workshops—composting methods and worm farming—which introduced residents to creating healthy soil from household organic waste.

The third workshop expanded these skills into practical, accessible ways to grow your own food, reduce waste, and develop resilient gardening habits that support a circular lifestyle. Urban Revolution guided participants through the essentials of sustainable, low-waste gardening, with a strong focus on:

- Heirloom seed quality and the importance of open-pollinated varieties
- Local seed sourcing to strengthen biodiversity and community food security
- Soil health and transforming organic waste into nutrient-rich growing systems
- Companion planting to naturally support plant growth
- Plant-based pest management, using ecological strategies instead of chemicals

A key highlight of the workshop was the exploration of the value of creating a community seed bank. Participants learned how locally saved seeds gradually adapt to local soil, climate, and seasonal conditions, becoming stronger, more resilient, and better suited to our environment. A community seed bank not only preserves biodiversity but also empowers residents to share resources, reduce gardening costs, and build long-term local food security together.

The workshop fostered a warm, collaborative atmosphere where participants asked questions, shared experiences, and connected over a shared commitment to sustainable living.

This event forms part of our ongoing dedication to community education, environmental stewardship, and circular living. More workshops will continue throughout the year to support our community in becoming GREAT SORTS for the planet. The next workshop, Recycling Right with Urban Revolution is 1pm, Thursday 9 July 2026

# Koomalin Clay Artist-in-Residence Program 2026

*Gaia Leonardi*

We're excited to welcome Gaia Leonardi to our community in Term 3. Gaia is an Italian ceramic artist and educator from Bottega Mirta Morigi in Faenza, bringing her unique blend of contemporary ceramics, creativity, and embodied learning.

She will be offering workshops in our schools as well as community workshops, inviting participants of all ages to explore clay through touch, play, and imagination. We're thrilled to have her join us and look forward to the inspiration she'll bring.

Gaia Leonardi moves through the world the way clay moves through her hands— with patience, intuition, and a quiet devotion to transformation.

Rooted in Faenza, the cradle of Italian ceramics, she shapes earth, breath, and gesture into a single language. Her work carries the softness of touch, the rhythm of the body, and the stories that emerge when hands meet material. In the studio of Bottega Mirta Morigi, she learned to listen to clay: its weight, its memory, its willingness to become.

Her practice is not confined to objects. It is a living dialogue— between movement and stillness, between children discovering their first coil of clay, between communities learning to feel at home in their bodies again.

As a psychomotor therapist, yoga teacher, and ceramic artist, Gaia weaves together the tactile and the emotional, the sculptural and the somatic. Her workshops are spaces where people breathe, play, ground, and create—where clay becomes a companion for self-expression and connection.

Her art is an invitation: to touch the world more gently, to shape it with intention, to remember that creation begins in the body long before it reaches the hands.

## COMMUNITY CONCERNS



Goomalling Police would like to remind the community — particularly parents and young riders — that we are actively targeting juveniles riding motorcycles unlicensed on public roads within the town.

Under Section 800 of the *Road Traffic Act*, police have the authority to stop, seize, and impound motorcycles being used unlawfully.

This applies where:

- The rider does not hold a valid licence, or
- The motorcycle is unregistered or not permitted for road use

Seized bikes may be impounded, with associated costs and further penalties applying.

We understand these bikes are popular with young people, but riding on public roads without the proper licence and registration puts riders and the community at serious risk.

Parents and guardians are encouraged to ensure young riders understand the rules and only ride in legal areas. Enforcement will continue to keep our town safe.

# FUEL SUPPORT PAYMENT AVAILABLE NOW FOR EVERY AUSTRALIAN LICENCE HOLDER

## Fuel Support Payment available for valid driver licence holders from 1 July

From 1 July 2026, all eligible Western Australian driver's licence holders can apply for the Fuel Support Payment.

The State Government has announced the one-off \$100 payment as a cost-of-living measure in the 2026-27 State Budget to assist Western Australian drivers with fuel costs and other financial pressures.

All WA driver's licence, learner's permit, provisional and extraordinary licence holders can apply. People with a cancelled, suspended or expired WA driver's licence are not eligible to apply.

You can claim the Fuel Support Payment on the ServiceWA app from 1 July 2026. Visit the [ServiceWA app: Support hub](#) for help to set up your ServiceWA app ahead of time.

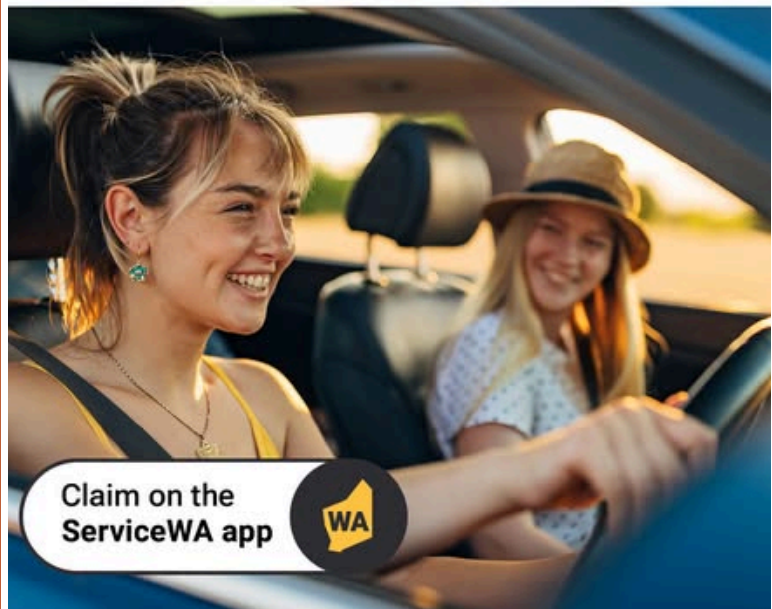

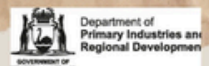


