Media Statement



The Shire of Goomalling acknowledges community interest regarding the future of the former St Paul's Anglican Church and wishes to provide some clarification regarding the discussions that have taken place concerning the building.

St Paul's Anglican Church was deconsecrated approximately three years ago and has not operated as a consecrated place of worship since that time.

In February/March, Council considered the potential future use of the building, including the possibility of incorporating it into initiatives associated with the Goomalling Biosphere Project. Council recognised the building's potential community value and was prepared to explore the possibility of taking ownership of the building to facilitate its ongoing use.

As part of this consideration, it was identified that approximately \$38,000 in works would be required to bring the building up to an appropriate standard. Council subsequently approached the Diocese regarding the undertaking and funding of these necessary repairs, with Council indicating its willingness to consider taking ownership of the building once the required works had been addressed.

Throughout much of 2025, there were numerous discussions and correspondence between the Shire and the Diocese in an effort to determine whether a mutually acceptable arrangement could be reached. Unfortunately, despite these efforts, an agreement regarding the future ownership, repair and ongoing maintenance responsibilities for the building could not be reached.

The Shire must also consider the financial implications associated with acquiring and maintaining the property. The land on which the church is situated is Crown land. Should Council seek to acquire the land, an application would be required to the State Government, with the potential purchase cost being based on market value, together with associated acquisition costs. The total cost to the Shire is currently estimated at approximately \$50,000, and importantly, an application would not guarantee that the land would ultimately be made available for purchase.

Council has a responsibility to ensure that public funds are managed prudently and that any acquisition of an asset is financially sustainable into the future. Given the significant costs associated with bringing the building to an appropriate standard, acquiring the underlying land and meeting ongoing maintenance obligations, Council is not currently in a financial position to take ownership of the property under the circumstances presented.

Council remains committed to supporting initiatives that provide positive outcomes for the Goomalling community and appreciates the community's interest in the future of this historic building. The Shire also acknowledges the heritage and community significance that St Paul's Anglican Church has held for the district and understands that its future is of interest to many residents.

This publication has been prepared and published by the Shire of Goomalling. Its purpose is to keep the Community and visitors informed of local events and activities. Publications will be issued fortnightly on a Friday and will be made available electronically via Shire website and links on our facebook page. Hard copies will be made available at Goomalling Post Office, The Village Grocer and Dunnings Roadhouse. **We welcome contributions from Community and Sporting Groups of ‘goings on’ in the Shire of Goomalling.** Shire of Goomalling will continue to publish the newsletter G’Day Goomalling on a quarterly basis.
