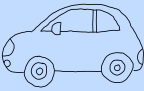

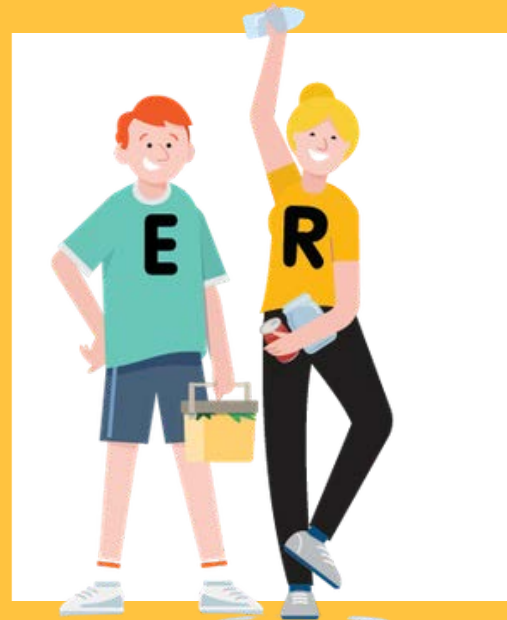

Waste Sorted Kids



Children explore sustainability through **three hands-on Waste Sorted Kids workshops**.

Making Compost in a Bottle, they learn how composting works and create their own bottle compost to watch the process develop over time.

Exploring Compost Creatures invites children to investigate real compost samples, observe tiny invertebrates with magnifiers, and record their discoveries in a mini booklet.

Waste Incursion helps children understand local bin systems and practice sorting waste correctly, finishing with a creative reuse craft to reinforce the importance of reducing and reusing materials.

LEGENDS

The 1906 built Headmasters house on Throssell Street (pictured below) was obtained by the Shire of Goomalling in 1979. Since then it has been used by the Historical Society, and briefly by the Lions Club for meetings.



Initially several busy bees were held by society members to work on the house and yard, and the community were asked for donations to furnish the residence.

The Historical Society, Lions Club and Apex Club members jointly paid the cost of painting the house, after they scraped and undercoated ready for the painter.



The Shire removed the Hills Hoist, assisted with connecting electricity and kindly donated the old Road Board table and chairs. Historical Society members and visitors sit in the refurbished chairs around the unique 5 legged table, surrounded by photographs of Road Board members.

The house is now open to visitors as part of the museum precinct.



The first Goomalling Road Board meeting of elected members was held in April 1895. The Road Board became the Shire Council in 1961.

The Goomalling Museum is located on Throssell Street, next to the pool and opposite Dunnings. The Facebook page 'Lost Goomalling' is also utilised to share and research our history.
