THE COOK MORE, WASTE LESS WORKSHOP

GO CIRCULAR – BE A GREAT SORT PROGRAM

The Cook More, Waste Less workshop, delivered in partnership with Grow Cook Eat WA and made possible through funding from the Government of Western Australia's WasteSorted Community Education Grants, brought nine participants together for a practical, hands-on session focused on reducing household food waste and building confidence in cooking with locally suited produce.

The workshop began with a group discussion exploring two key questions: What are you currently doing to reduce food waste? and What grows well in our region? Participants shared their experiences, tips and challenges, creating a collaborative learning environment that set the tone for the session. This conversation highlighted the diversity of local soil types—sandy, clay and gravel—and the importance of understanding how to improve soil structure to support productive home gardens. The group explored simple, achievable methods to enrich soil and make better use of home-grown ingredients.

Three cooking stations were set up, each featuring a recipe designed to minimise waste and showcase adaptable, seasonal ingredients:

- Cauliflower & Cashew Korma
- Date Balls
- Strawberry, Sunflower & Avocado Salad
- Gnocchi

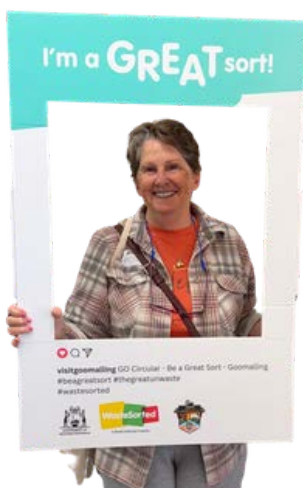


Participants spread across three stations, preparing dishes, sharing ideas, and building confidence in reducing waste through thoughtful cooking. The workshop concluded with everyone coming together to enjoy a shared meal, creating space for connection, conversation, and celebration of the food they had prepared.

This workshop reinforced the core message of the GO Circular – Be A Great Sort Program: practical changes in the kitchen and garden can significantly reduce household waste while strengthening community knowledge and resilience.

“That was a great session, the ladies were great and the food was awesome! We made gnocchi, cauli korma, strawberry spinach salad and date balls.

One of the ladies didn't want to try the korma, but I persuaded her to taste a bit of the sauce on a teaspoon. She not only had a plate of it, she took home a container full! Win Win”
