



PUBLIC NOTICE

The Shire of Goomalling is currently reviewing its Disability Access and Inclusion Plan and is seeking submissions from interested persons to assist us in developing a new 5-year Plan.

There are 7 outcomes we need to address, which are;

Outcome 1: People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to access the services of, and any events organised by, Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 2: People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to access to buildings and facilities of the Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 3: People with disabilities receive the information from the Shire of Goomalling in a format that will enable them to access the information as readily as other people are able to access it.

Outcome 4: People with disabilities receive the same level and quality of service from the staff of the Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 5: People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to make complaints to the Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 6: People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to participate in any public consultation by the Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 7: People with disability have the same opportunities as other people to obtain and maintain employment with the Shire of Goomalling.

We would like to know: -

- How could we make our buildings more assessable for people with disabilities. Have you or have you observed any difficulties by others in getting into our buildings?
Is lighting adequate in our buildings?
- Are street crossings and footpaths assessable by wheelchairs, gophers and the like.?
- Have you or others endeavoured to take part in physical, cultural or sporting activities but found that there were barriers in the way which prevented you from being involved?
- Is there buildings owned by the Council you feel should have specific toilet facilities for people with disabilities. Are the ones we have in our main assembly type buildings adequate?

If you have any ideas that would enhance our Disability Access and Inclusion Plan for any of Council's infrastructure or operations, please let us know.
