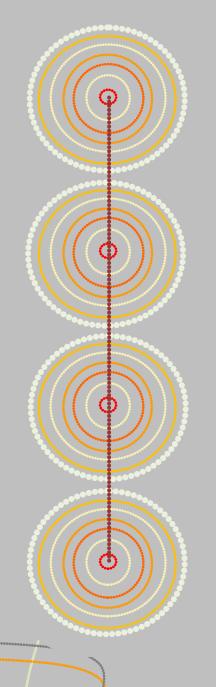

All the dogs are sterilized and microchipped and are friendly.

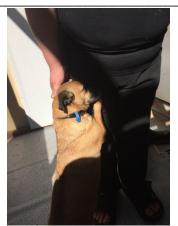
Even though the fencing between the front and back yard is made of different materials I feel that it is secure enough to contain these dogs.

The dogs are not able to gain access under the house and the cat door is screwed shut. Jason is aware that he needs to clean his yard area up.

History: The 3rd dog Sheeba did belong to Jason's sister but she was no longer able to care for her. The only history that is noted on our system is that the dogs were not registered until the Ranger did a compliance check in the area. We have not received any complaints about the dogs and the dogs have never escaped the premises to our knowledge.

Nature of Council's Role in the Matter

Legislative

Purpose of Report

To authorise the affixing of the Common Seal to the Schedule "B" Goomalling Public Cemetery Form of Grant of Right Burial, Grant No. 115 for Glenys Woolhouse's tenure of Grave No. 51 in the Niche Wall.

Background

In simple terms, a Grant of Right of Burial, or, Grant, is the tenure agreement over a stated burial plot which confers upon the holder of the Grant, known as the Grantee, the right to conduct burials, inter ashes and erect a monument within the burial plot.

Under the 1986 Act, the maximum guaranteed tenure on any given plot is 50 years although this is able to be extended for further 25 year periods at the discretion of the managing cemetery authority.

Extensions can only be in 25 year increments.
