Nature of Council's Role in the Matter

The roll of Council in this matter is to approve the Disability Access & Inclusion Plan 2018 – 2023 to cover the next five years.

Purpose of Report

The Shire President Barry Haywood and Councillor Julie Chester have reviewed the plan and will seek the endorsement of other elected members.

Background

The first Disability Access and Inclusion Plan was developed in 2006 and there were 6 outcomes to the Plan for Council to address. In 2014 one more outcome was added.

Comments and details

Within the Plan reference is made to Council's Disability Access Advisory Committee which has come about using the template sent out by the Disability Service Commission in 2006 and has been in the last two plan reviews.

Councillors in the past have resolved that a committee would be formed if the need arose, where the Council administration was unable to apply the outcomes set out as follows and needed guidance from the elected members.

The seven (7) outcomes are:

- **Outcome 1:** People with a disability have the same opportunities as other people to access the services of, and any events organised by, the Shire of Goomalling.
- **Outcome 2:** People with a disability have the same opportunities as other people to access to buildings and facilities of the Shire of Goomalling.
- **Outcome 3:** People with a disability receive the information from the Shire of Goomalling authority in a format that will enable them to access the information as readily as other people are able to access it.
- **Outcome 4:** People with a disability receive the same level and quality of service from the staff of the Shire of Goomalling.
- **Outcome 5:** People with a disability have the same opportunities as other people to make complaints to the Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 6: People with a disability have the same opportunities as other people to participate in any public

consultation by the Shire of Goomalling.

Outcome 7: People with a disability have the same opportunities as other people to obtain and maintain

employment with a public authority.
